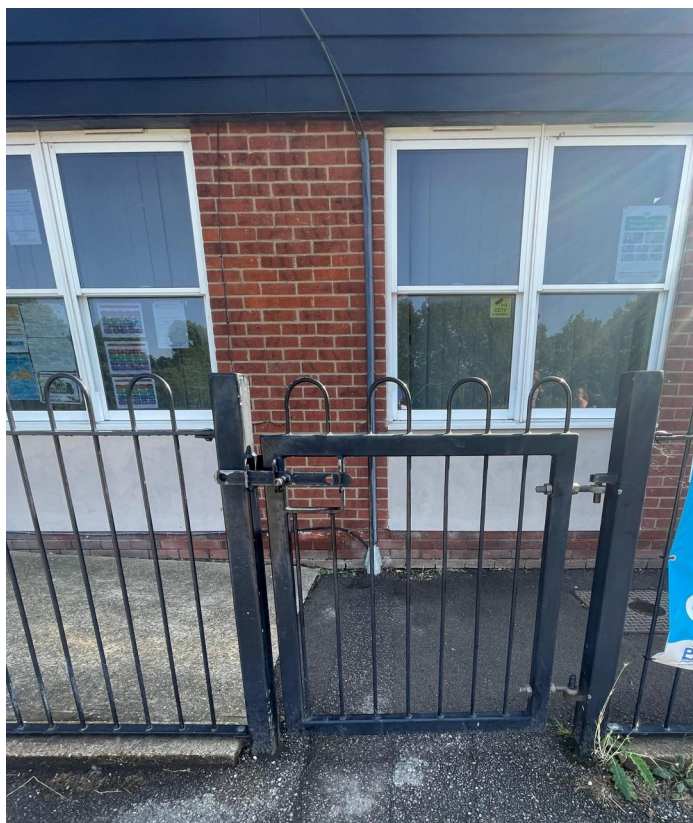

When I arrive at my classroom, I put my bag and coat in my locker.



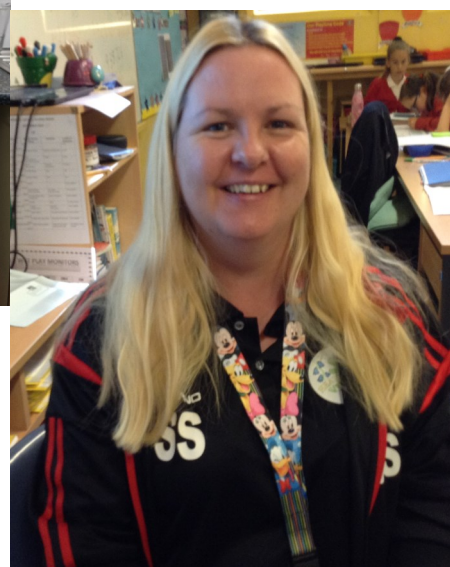
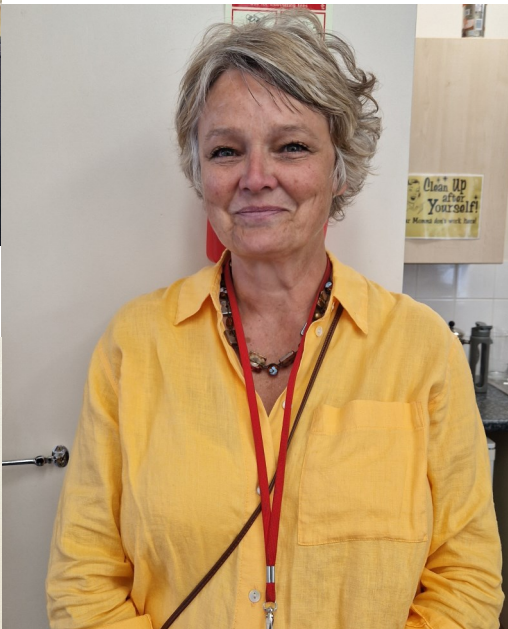
This is the classroom.

These adults may cover the class when Mrs Gibson is not in: Mr Minter, Mrs White, Mrs Carter, Mrs Skinner and Miss Heard.



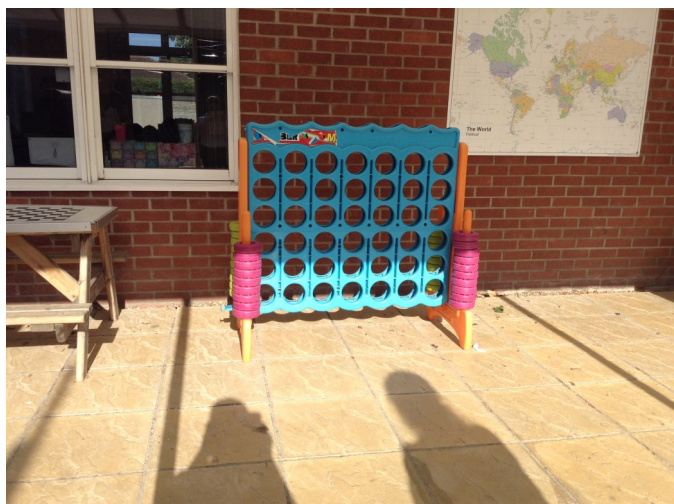
This is the toilet area.

This is the boys lobby. I will have a locker, this is where I keep my bag and coat.

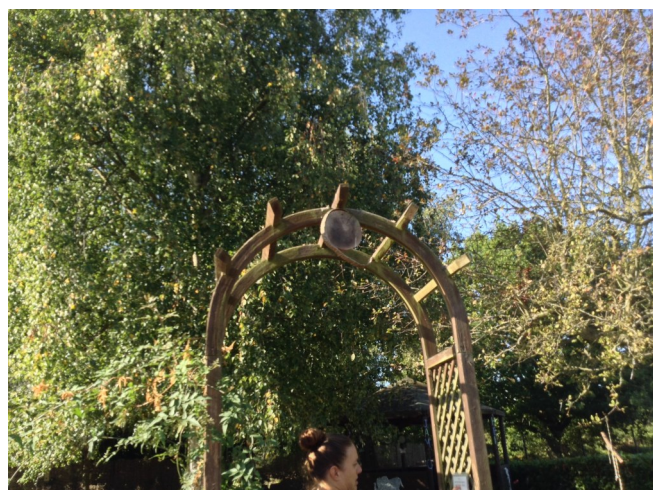


This is the girls lobby. I will have a locker, this is where I keep my bag and coat.
