This group of children will meet regularly to discuss how they can make a difference to Heathlands school life.


They will also attend a short part of the Governing body meetings each term.

Our School Council is a group of pupils who meet regularly to discuss how they can make a difference to school life for all pupils.

There will be regular meetings with a large number of other schools to discuss how changes to school life will develop all children.
